Pink Lady

Pink Lady is a crisp and juicy apple with acidic undertones, dense firm flesh and an excellent, almost effervescent, flavour.

Fuji

CHARACTERISTICS

Developed in Japan and named after the mountain, Fuji is a large, popular apple with a honey sweet taste. It has a firm, crisp texture, and is very juicy with an extremely dense flesh.

Visually, Fuji exhibits a red/dull pink blush over a greeny-yellow background.

Cox Orange Pippin

CHARACTERISTICS

Cox Orange Pippin arose in England in the 19th century as a chance seedling, and remains unsurpassed for its richness and complexity of flavour.

An early season variety, it exhibits a red blush to stripe on a light yellow skin with a firm, crisp texture and a rich sprightly sub-acid aromatic flavour.
